WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 8 (DINNER)

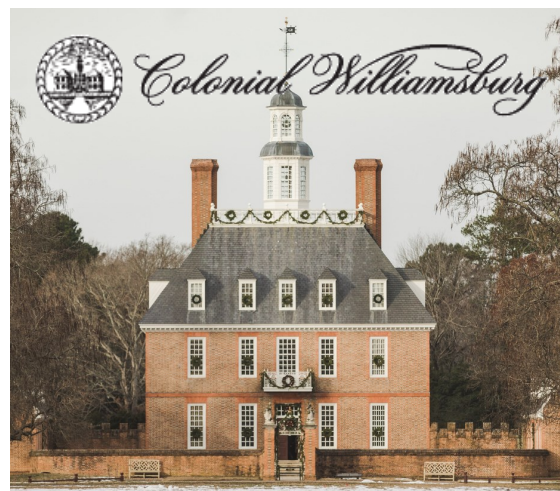
This morning our flight takes us to **Norfolk, Virginia** where our deluxe motor coach will transport us to **Williamsburg, VA**. Upon our arrival we'll check into the magnificent **Williamsburg Lodge** for two nights. Located within walking distance of historic Colonial Williamsburg and Market Square, the lodge features beautiful folk art furnishings, charming lantern-lined hallways, and guest rooms decorated in a classic Virginia style. This evening we will dine at candlelit tables set with period-style plates and utensils at the reconstructed 18th-century **Shields Tavern**. Partake of tasty southern fare in this unique restaurant.

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 9 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

Enjoy breakfast this morning before you begin your discovery of **Colonial Williamsburg**, which will be decked out for the holidays! Williamsburg was founded in 1632 and served as the Capital of the Colony of Virginia from 1699 - 1780. It became the center of political events in Virginia that led to the American Revolution. Become a part of the saga as the city comes alive to depict the days, months, and years leading up to that historic time. Meet the political figures, tradespeople, shopkeepers, townspeople, and African Americans to learn about their hopes, struggles, and fears in these uncertain times. Choose to participate in a trial reenactment at the courthouse, watch an 18th century drum and bugle corps parade and visit the **Governor's Palace**. You may also wish to visit **Merchant's Square**, an 18th-century retail village with shops, art galleries and restaurants. Tonight we'll enjoy a delicious meal at the **Aberdeen Barn**, voted "best steakhouse" by readers of the *Virginia Gazette*.

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 10 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

After a leisurely morning we begin our journey to **Washington, D.C.** Along the way we will stop at **Mount Vernon**, the historic plantation estate of our first president, George Washington. Through a home tour and exhibits, you will learn about the man who earned the trust of his countrymen and voluntarily led an inexperienced army against Great Britain, the world's most powerful military force at the time. Later we'll check into the **Holiday Inn Capital** for three nights. This deluxe hotel is located just minutes from the National Mall and DC's top attractions. Tonight we depart for an exciting evening on the **Odyssey dinner cruise** on the **Potomac River**. Marvel at the sophisticated ambiance of our unique, low-profile, nearly all glass vessel which affords amazing views. Choose from a variety of creative appetizers, entrees, and mouth-watering desserts prepared fresh onboard daily. Enjoy live entertainment, dancing and illuminated views of Washington that will take your breath away!

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 11 (BREAKFAST)

A lovely breakfast is served at the hotel's **Capital Bistro** and then we board our coach to experience the magnificence of our nation's Capital! A **local guide** will take us to see the **Memorials and Monuments** that honor the visionaries, revolutionaries, patriots and heroes that were responsible for shaping the country we live in today. See the **Washington Monument**, the **Thomas Jefferson Memorial**, the **Lincoln Memorial** and the **F.D.R. Memorial**. Solemnly remember those who have helped keep our nation free as you stroll past the **National World War II Memorial**, the **Korean War Veterans Memorial** and the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**. This afternoon we'll stop at the **Marine Corps War Memorial** (also called the Iwo Jima Memorial) and then visit **Arlington National Cemetery**, our nation's most hallowed ground. An **interpretive tour bus** will take you to special points of interest like the **Kennedy gravesites**, **The Tomb of the Unknowns** (to see the Changing of the Guard), and **The Arlington House** (the Robert E. Lee Memorial). This evening you are on your own to dine in one of the many wonderful restaurants near our hotel.



SUNDAY, DECEMBER 12 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

After breakfast we'll depart on another day of sightseeing in Washington, D.C. Our **guide** will take us past the **White House**, the **Capitol**, the **Bureau of Printing and Engraving**, the **Library of Congress**, and the **National Archives**. See the buildings where our congressmen and senators convene and learn about our nation's diplomatic mission as we drive along **Embassy Row**. This afternoon is free for you to explore the museums that interest you most at the **Smithsonian Institution**, the world's largest museum complex and research organization. The Air and Space Museum, the Natural History Museum and the American History Museum are just a few of the many choices available to you. This evening we will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant followed by a drive to view the holiday lights and illuminated monuments.

MONDAY, DECEMBER 13 (BREAKFAST)

This morning we bid farewell to our nation's capital and travel to **Annapolis, Maryland's** historic capital city. On arrival we will visit the **United States Naval Academy**. From its founding in 1845, the Academy has grown from a fleet of sail and steam-powered ships to a high-tech fleet with nuclear-powered submarines and surface ships and supersonic aircraft. The Academy gives midshipmen the up-to-date academic and professional training they need to be effective naval officers in their assignments to protect our country. See the exhibits in the **Visitor's Center** and take a **guided walking tour** to better understand the Academy's mission to develop midshipmen morally, mentally, and physically. Afterward you will have free time to enjoy lunch on your own and stroll along the historic, cobbled streets of Annapolis. Later we will make our way to the Baltimore-Washington airport for our flight home. We'll be filled with an uplifted patriotic and holiday spirit!



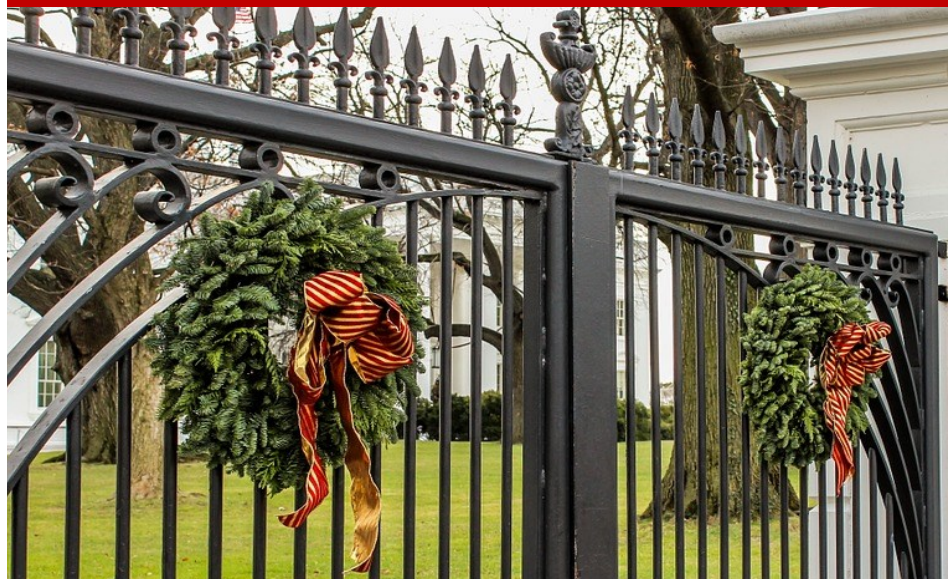
